Things are still the same honey. I haven't received any mail since I got those 25 the other day. But honey, I read your last ones all the time. Dearest, I'm so very much in love with you. Gee honey, I'll be so glad when I get back. Guess what honey, we got our officers liquor ration today. 2 bottles of champagne, 1 scotch, 1 gin, & 1 cognac. See dear there are a few things good about war.

Well dear, I'll say goodbye for today. Remember darling I love you with all my heart. Tell Pops hello & pet Mitzi. Don't worry dearest.
