To my dearest wife,

 in love with you. Only thing wrong is I'm lonely  
 and cold. Honey, I haven't seen to any writing  
 paper now, so you'll have to settle for this V-mail.  
 It will probably get there before my last year  
 letter.

Things are still the same honey. I haven't received  
 any mail since I got them 25 the other day. But honey,  
 I read your last one all the time. Dearest, I'm  
 so very much in love with you. See honey, it  
 be so glad when I get back. Guess what honey. We got  
 an official liquor ration today. 2 bottles champagne, 1 each, 1/2  
 + 1 cognac. See dear there are a few things good about war.  
 Well dear, I'd say goodbye for today. Remember, darling, I love  
 you with all my heart. Tell the boys I love them too.  
 I get with you. Best love, sweet
